

(5) Also all those nine certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being on Verner Heights, in the County and State aforesaid, and being the same lots of land conveyed to W.A. Simpson by C.C. Hindman by deed dated Apr. 3, 1909 and recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 4, page 443, said lots being designated as Lots Nos. 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 40, 41 and 42 on plat recorded in said office in Plat Book "A" page 125. Being the same lots conveyed to the Grantor by the said W.A. Simpson by deed dated Dec. 15, 1910 and recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 9, page 574.

(6) All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate in the western suburbs of the City of Greenville just outside the corporate limits of said City on the east side of Endel Street, and having the following metes and bounds to wit: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of Endel St. corner of lot heretofore conveyed by W.C. Cleveland to Mr. Miller, and running thence with Miller's line S. $67\frac{1}{2}$ E. $151\frac{1}{2}$ feet to an iron pin on 12-foot alley; thence along line of said alley S. 20 W. $50\frac{1}{2}$ feet, more or less, to an iron pin; thence N. $67\frac{1}{2}$ W. $152\frac{1}{2}$ feet to an iron pin on Endel Street; thence along said Street N. 23 E. $50\frac{1}{2}$ feet, more or less, to the beginning corner. Being a portion of the lot of land conveyed to the grantor by Thos. E. Bolling by his deed dated Fe. 20, 1909, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for said County in Vol. 4, page 30.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belong or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns forever.

And the granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee hereinabove named and his heirs and assigns against itself and its successors and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

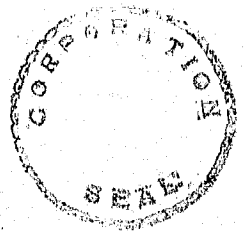
