TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned, unto the said

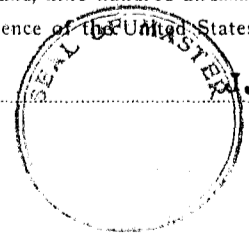

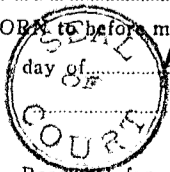
