demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 4th day of Sept. 1915, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be sold by E. for the sum of Eighteen Hundred and Five (\$1805.00) Dollars, being at that price the highest bidder therefor. NOW, THEREFORE, Know all men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman, Master in and for County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Eighteen Hundred and five (\$1805.00) Dollars, to me paid by the said W.D.Parrish and T.C.Gower

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said W.D.Parrish and T.C.Gower, the following described real estate. "All that certain parcel, piece, or tract of land situated in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the city of Greenville, on the South side of Mulberry Street, one hundred fifty-three and three-fourths feet from the corner of Pinkney and Mulberry Streets and running with Mulberry Street fifty feet to an iron pin, having a depth of one hundred thirty-one feet, more or less, known as lot No. 6 on plat two of the real estate of S.P. Burbage; see said Plat in Judge Rool NO. 2119. Also that other lot adjoining the above described lot on the northeast side; beginning at an iron pin on Mulberry St., at the corner of lot NO. 6 and running thence five feet to an iron pin; thence in a southeasterly direction one hundred thirty-one feet to an iron pin; thence S. 57 W. ten feet to an iron pin; thence N 32 W. one hundred thirty-one feet to the beginning."
