Gray, Master in and for County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Sixteen Hundred and Forty Dollars, to me paid by the said Asa A. Green and Lula R. Green, in the following proportions, to-wit: one-third thereof by the said Asa A. Green and the remaining two-thirds thereof by the said Lula R. Green,the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Asa A. Green and Lula R. Green, All that certain parcel or lot of land, situate in County and State aforesaid, known as Lot No. 7, in the plat of survey of the lands of which Martha J. Howell, died, seized and possessed, made by W. L. Adams, Surveyor, on the 10th day of March, 1914, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit; beginning at a stake on Spartanburg Road, corner of Lot No. 6, and running thence N. 11 E. 94 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 6; thence N. 85 1/4 W. 254 feet, passing through center of well, to a stake in middle of Creek; thence S. 39 1/4 W. 83 1/2 feet to a stake corner of Lot No. 3; thence S. 80 1/2 E. 23 feet to a stake, on bank of Creek; thence S. 80 1/2 E. 290 feet to the beginning corner.Plat of the above property recorded in Plat Book "C"
