is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

T.R. Smith, G.W. Mayfield, P.B. Thackston, J.D. Mayfield and T.R. Owings, Deacons of the Clear Springs Baptist Church, all that piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in Austin Township and the State and County aforesaid:

Beginning on a stone at the southwestern corner of the cemetery of said Church, and running thence N. 1/2 E. 3.36 along the line of said cemetery lot to a stone; thence N. 89-1/2 W. 1.82 to a stone; thence S. 1/2 W. 2.00 to a stone; thence along the road S. 54-1/2 E. 2.26 to the beginning stone or corner, said lot contains one-half acre, more or less, and is conveyed to said Deacons to be used as a cemetery or for any other purpose that the officers of said Church may think advisable.
