KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Mary A. Gillespie, (sometimes spelled Gillispie), E.M. Gillespie and Mary J. Cartledge, three of the heirs at law and distributees of J.D. Gillespie, deceased who departed this life intestate, leaving surviving him as his sole heirs at-law and distributees his wife, Mary A. Gillespie of Greenville County, S.C. and his three children, viz:- J.T. Gillespie, E.M. Gillespie of Greenville County, S.C. and Mary J. Cartledge of Augusta, Ga. all of whom have attained the age of twenty-one (21) years respectively in the State aforesaid.

in consideration of the sum of Sixteen hundred (\$1600.00) DOLLARS, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J.T. Gillespie, of Greenville County, S.C.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J.T. Gillespie, his heirs and assigns, all our right, title, interest, estate, claim and demand whatsoever, both at law and in equity, in and to all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land containing One and one-half (1-1/2) acres, more or less, situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, in the State of South Carolina and in Greenville County, near the City of Greenville: Beginning at a corner of the property of the Southern Railway; thence running South with line of Sallie Lowens 489 feet; thence East with line of Ida J. Seyle's 136 feet; thence North with line of Ida J. Seyle's 489 feet; thence West 145 feet to the Newton Lake corner, adjoining lands of Ida J. Seyle's, T.J. Seyle's, Charlie Lowens and others, and being the same tract of land conveyed to me, the said J.D. Gillespie by a deed bearing date 7th, day of November 1902 and recorded in Deed Book J.J.J. at page 36 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in State of South Carolina.
