DEED TO Arch Jamison

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

COUNTY OF Greenville

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Annie B. Walker,

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of

Five Dollars and other valuable consideration, DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by Arch Jamison

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Arch Jamison, his heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel and tract of land, lying and being in State and County aforesaid, about two miles from Greenville Court House, on Saunders Hill Road, and containing forty-five (45) acres, more or less, and beginning at a stone on Saunders Hill Road; thence along said Road N. 79 E. 12.70 to a stone 3x; thence N. 26 1/2 W. 39.10 to a stone 3x; thence S. 62 W. 11.80 to a stone 3x; thence S. 25 1/2 E. 35.00 to the beginning corner, and known as the "Grant Place", being one of the tracts of land conveyed to me by C. H. Judson, Treas. by deed dated the 5th day of August, 1893; deed recorded in Vol. A A A, page 129.

Also all that other certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in said County and State, about two miles N. E. from Greenville Court House, and said to contain eight (8) acres, more or less, and having the following lines, meters and bounds: - Beginning on a stone 3x, and running thence N. 62 - 3/4 E. 10.80 to a stone 3x N; thence N. 30 W. 8.10 to a stone 3x N; thence S. 54 1/2 W. 11 to a stone 3x O; thence S. 30 E. 6.57 to the beginning; being same tract of land conveyed to me by J. Q. Donaldson by deed dated the 26th day of January, 1899; deed recorded in Vol. 777, page 444.

Geer, Treasurer of Furman University, hereby releases and relinquishes unto the within named Arch Jamison, his heirs and assigns, forever the lien of a mortgage which was executed to C. H. Judson, Treasurer of Furman University, the 5th day of September, 1893, recorded in Vol. 11, page 37, to secure a note for \$1300.00, this said release being a release from the lien of said mortgage of so much of the land covered thereby as is described in the within deed.
