DEED TO

J. W. Pickle Simer

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

I, Silas McCreary

in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of
Twelve hundred and eighty eight (\$1288) DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by J. W. Picklesimer

(the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J. W. Pickle Simer all the following described pieces, parcel or tract of land
situate lying and being in the country and state aforesaid, in
Butler Township; Being a part of the Jerry M. Kilgore place and
bounded as follows: Beginning at an iron pin and standing
in the South line of the aforesaid place and runs thence N. 38 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 36 3 ft
to an iron pin; thence N. 55 W. 320 ft. to an iron pin; thence S. 7 - W.
575 feet to an iron pin in the said South line above mentioned; thence
with same S. 45 E. 535 feet to the beginning corner, containing six and
one half (6 $\frac{1}{2}$) acres more or less, being the same tract of land conveyed to
Jerry M. Kilgore by the Greenville Trust Company on Feb. 15, 1912 and being the
same tract of land conveyed to the Greenville Trust Company by Jerry M. Kilgore on
June 3, 1911, by deed recorded in R.M.C. office for said County and State, in
Book 13 page 198. Reference is hereby made to the contents of the deed by Greenville
Trust Company to Jerry M. Kilgore of Feb. 15, 1912 wherein it appears that J. W.
Pickle Simer and G. V. T. Blythe released any claim, equity or interest in said
tract of land, see deed recorded in Vol. 19, page 353, R.M.C. Office. Also a one-half
interest in lot no. 7 of tract made by T. G. Rogers for City View Land Company
and duly record in Plat Book "D" at page 327 of R.M.C. office for Greenville
County, described by metes and bounds as follows: Beginning at a stake on the North side of
O'Neal Avenue at corner of lot no. 6. and runs thence 194 feet with the west lines of lots
6, 5, and 4 to a stake; thence W. with line of lot no. 8 — feet to a stake in the East margin
of an unnamed street; thence with the east margin of said street 164 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a stake at
the junction of said street with O'Neal Avenue; thence E. with the North margin of said O'Neal Ave.
35 feet to the beginning. And it is understood and agreed that the said J. W. Pickle Simer shall not sell, lease or rent
the above described lot to any one being or having ever descent, any violation of this agreement shall be construed
a breach of contract and shall render this deed null and void. Said lands being fully described in a deed from
J. D. Moody to J. W. Pickle Simer, et al, dated April 25th, 1911, and duly recorded in Book 11 page 419, R.M.C. office
for Greenville County. Also a one-half interest in another tract of land situate about 2 miles East of Greenville
S.C. known as the Jerry Kilgore place and fully described in a deed from Jerry Kilgore to J. W. Pickle Simer
and G. V. T. Blythe, dated June 3, 1911, and duly recorded in Book 13 at page 223 R.M.C. office for
Greenville County, and described by metes and bounds as follows: Beginning at a stake in the County road
leading from Wood's Crossing to the Limestone Hill, and runs thence N. 45 W. 827 feet to a stake;
thence N. 38 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 565 feet to a stake; thence N. 55 W. 320 feet to a stake; thence S. 7 W. 575 feet
to a stake; thence N. 45 W. 347 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a stake; thence N. 49 E. 838 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a stake;
thence N. 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 550 feet to a stake at the County road leading from Limestone Hill to
Greenville; thence S. 65 E. 1430 feet to a stake; thence S. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 550 feet to a stake
and thence S. 33 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 1402 ft. to the beginning, containing 56 acres more or
less excepting therefore the $\frac{1}{4}$ of an acre hereto fore conveyed to the
trustees of Socorro Industrial Lodge; for description of same see deed
duly recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County. For the last
