KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I Sallie Hart Harris, Attorney-in-fact for the heirs of Mrs. Fannie E. Harris, deceased, under deed of record in the Clerk's office of Greenville County, Greenville, S. C.

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of

Ten dollars and no other valuable considerations DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by

Sallie Hart Harris

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Sallie Hart Harris, one tract certain lot or parcel of land, together with all and singular the buildings and improvements thereon, situated, lying and being on Elkins Street, in the city of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, bounded and described as follows, to wit: Beginning at S. P. 3X, the 3X of N. P. Whitman lot and running thence with said lot 50°-30' E. 221, 5' to an S. P. in rear line; thence N. 66° 15' E. 106' to an S. P. 3X; thence N. 0°-30' W. 163' to an S. P. 3X on South side of Elkins Street; thence with Elkins Street, N. 80°-45' W. 100' to the beginning 3X - Same being a portion of the real estate whereof the late Mrs. Fannie E. Harris died, seized and possessed and which was conveyed by and to the heirs-at-law of the said Mrs. Fannie E. Harris, deceased to the said Sallie Hart Harris, as their attorney-in-fact as aforesaid, with full power and authority to make conveyance thereof by good and sufficient deed - To which said deed duly recorded in said Clerk's office, reference is hereby made.
