

Greenville Traction Company DEED TO Jerry M. Harris

State of South Carolina, WHEREAS, Jerry M. Harris on the 9th. day of March 1903, executed and delivered to Greenville Traction Company his deed and thereby conveyed to it a certain right-of-way and other privileges over and across the lands hereinafter described:

AND WHEREAS the purpose of this deed is to divest said Company of and to re-invest said Jerry M. Harris with every interest, estate, right and privilege conveyed by said above mentioned deed, NOW KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Greenville Traction a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at

Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars and other good and valuable consideration DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

Jerry M. Harris, his heirs and assigns, all of its rights, title, interest, estate and privileges granted it by said Jerry M. Harris by deed dated the 9th. day of March 1903, and recorded in Book J. J. J. at page 543, same consisting of a right of way thirty feet wide over and through the three tracts of land of the said Jerry M. Harris, situate and being in the County and State aforesaid, lying on both sides of the Easley Bridge road, adjoining the Cely, Bagwell and Yown lands, containing about 194 acres, more or less, together with sufficient space for any switches, side tracks and stations not to exceed in the aggregate thirty feet in width and five hundred feet in length, it being the intention of the grantor herein to re-convey to the grantee herein all of the rights, title, interest and privileges acquired by the grantor herein under and by virtue of said deed and to fully and completely divest itself of the same.

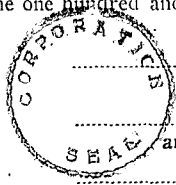
TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee... hereinafter named, and his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee... hereinafter named, and his heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against all and singular persons claiming or to claim hereunto in anywise.

In witness whereof the said granting corporation has caused its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and these presents to be subscribed by its duly authorized officers, on this the 19th. day of August, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eleven, and in the one hundred and 36th. year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.

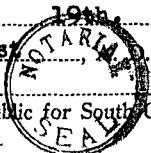
