KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Pride & Patton Land Company

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Thirteen hundred DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

Robt. I. Woodside, his heirs and assigns forever, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Ward 2 of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and designated as Lot No. 4 on plat made by W.D. Neves on the 12th, day of Nov. 1908, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at the corner of Lot No. 3 on the Washington Road, and running thence N. 69 35' E. 75 feet and 1 in. to an iron pin; thence N. 18 35' W. 212 feet and 1 in. to an iron pin on alley; thence with said alley S. 69 35' W. 71 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot No. 3; thence with the line of Lot No. 3, S. 17 24' E. 212 feet to the beginning corner, and being a part of the same lot of land conveyed to Pride & Patton Land Company by C.J. Pride, and W.L. Patton by deed dated March 25th, 1908 and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Volume "ZZZ", page 35.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

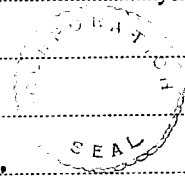
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee...hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee... hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

In witness whereof the said granting corporation has caused its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and these presents to be subscribed by its duly authorized officers, C.J. Pride, President and W.L. Patton, Secretary and Treasurer on this the 29th, day of Nov., in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and ten, and in the one hundred and thirty-fifth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
