Nancy E. Floyd, all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City
 of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:
 Beginning at an iron pin on West side Rowley Street, at corner of lot owned by Dave Burns, and
 running; thence with said line of Dave Burns and also with line of C.H. Craskey's lot
 N. 69.29 W. two hundred and ten (210) feet to an alley; thence with said alley S. 20.19 W.
 fifty-one (51) feet and nine and 3/4 (9-3/4) inches to a stake at corner of Beneyfield's lot;

 in consideration of the sum of five Dollars, Acree, as well as the love and affection I have for my daughter, Alice
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by
 Alice Acree (the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Alice Acree, and unto her heirs and assigns forever, All that certain piece, parcel and lot
 of land containing 27/100 of an acre, more or less, situate, lying and being in the Southwestern
 portion of the City of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid, and in the 5th, Ward
 thereof, on the North side of Williams Street, sometimes called Jenkins Street and having the
 following metes and bounds to wit:
 Beginning at a stake 3X0 on said Street and running thence N. 12-1/2 E. 3.25 chs. to a stake 3X0
