in consideration of the sum of Twenty-six hundred and sixty No/100. (\$2660.00) DOLLARS.
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by
James I. West (the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

James I. West, his heirs and assigns, all my one half interest in that certain, piece, parcel
and tract of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, about four miles
from the City of Greenville, on the Spartanburg Road, being a part of the tract of land conveyed
to J.J. McCarter by J.A. McCarter and more fully described by plat made by W.A. Hudson:
Beginning on iron pin in the Spartanburg Road and with said Road as a line S. 63-1/2 E. 6.11
to an angle in said road; thence S. 73-2 E. 4.10 to a stone on road (formerly Black oak);
thence N. 12-2/3 E. 15.57 to stone; thence N. 89 E. 1.86 to Black gum; thence N. 49-2/3 W.
40.50 to Black gum in Brushy Creek at intersection of ditch; thence S. 24 E. 42.00 to the
beginning corner, containing forty-four and one-half (44-1/2) acres, more or less, being the same
tract of land conveyed to James I. West and J.A. Norris by J.J. McCarter by deed dated September

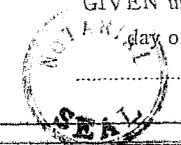
