KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, W.D. Parrish and T.C. Gower, of the City of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, trading as partners under the firm name of Parrish and Gower, in consideration of the sum of Five thousand dollars DOLLARS, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Mrs. Elizabeth E. McHugh (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Elizabeth E. McHugh, her heirs and assigns, all that lot of land situate on the South side of Mulberry Street, in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina, beginning at a point on said Street one hundred and fifty feet from Buncombe Street, and runs thence in a line parallel with Buncombe Street, along the line of Mrs. Goodwin's lot, one hundred and six feet; thence in a line parallel with Mulberry Street, sixty feet; thence in a line parallel with the first above mentioned line one hundred and six feet to Mulberry Street; thence along Mulberry Street, sixty feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot of land conveyed to us by L.I. Jennings, by deed dated February 1st, 1913, and recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 24, page 276.
