KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, R.A. Brown
in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of Ten dollars and other valuable considerations xxxxxxxxxx
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

A. White (the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

A. White, his heirs and assigns, all of my undivided right, title and interest (being one-half)
of, in and to all that tract of land situate in the State and County aforesaid, about two and
one-half miles from Greenville Court House, near the Farmers Oil Mill, on the White Horse
Road, containing forty-seven (47) acres, more or less, and bounded by lands of Davis, T.A.-
Honour and estate of Earle, and being the same tract of land conveyed to said A. White and
myself by W.G. Trotter, and to him by the Norwood National Bank of Greenville.

TOGETHER WITH, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-
wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said
A. White, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and
forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said A. White, his

heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against
every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
