in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Sixteen hundred (\$1600.00) DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

Ocoola Real Estate and Insurance Company (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Ocoola Real Estate and Insurance Company All that certain piece or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville County of Greenville and in the State of South Carolina, on Stone Avenue in said City of Greenville (and upon which there is a now standing a one-story frame dwelling). Beginning at a point on the North side of said Stone Avenue fifty-four and one-half (54-1/2) feet from East Elizabeth Street; thence along said Stone Avenue fifty-four and one-half feet (54-1/2); thence toward Earle Street two hundred six and one-half feet (206-1/2); thence in the direction of Main Street fifty-four and one-half feet (54-1/2); thence toward said Stone Avenue two hundred six and one-half feet (206-1/2) to the beginning corner. The same being lot number fourteen, as shown on plat made by J.N. Southern and recorded in Book V.V. page 544 in the office of R.M.C. for Greenville County and deeded to me by W.W.
