TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME OR BE MADE KNOWN, or whom the same may in anywise concern, I, Walter M. Scott, as Judge of the Court of Probate for Greenville County, in the said State, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Addison D. Young as executor of the estate of Emma Ross, deceased on or about the 17th day of March in the year one thousand nine hundred and nineteen did exhibit his Complaint in the Court of Probate, in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, for the sale of the Real Estate of Emma Ross in aid of personal assets to pay debts of the deceased

And the Cause being at issue before the Honorable the Court aforesaid, came on to be heard on the 2nd day of June one thousand nine hundred and 19, when the said Court, after a full hearing thereof and mature deliberation in the premises, did Order, Adjudge and Decree that the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, should be sold at public auction by the Judge of the Court of Probate for Greenville County, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said Decretal Order, as by reference thereto, on file in the said Court, will appear: And the said Judge of the Court of Probate, after having duly advertised the said lands or real estate for sale by public outcry, on the 7th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and nineteen DID then, openly and publicly and according to the custom of auction, sell and dispose of the said real estate described below unto Henry Campbell for Fifteen hundred and fifty-five dollars being at that price the highest bidder for same.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Walter M. Scott as Judge of the Court of Probate as aforesaid, in consideration of the premises, and also in consideration of the sum of \$1,555.00 DOLLARS,

paid me by the said Henry Campbell the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. HAVE granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, DO grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Henry Campbell and his heirs and assigns forever, ALL those certain pieces and parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being in Greenville City, Greenville County, South Carolina, on Ann Street; Lot No. 1: Beginning at a stake on the north side of Ann Street at Tom Halls corner, and running thence N. 12-1/4 W. 110-1/2 feet to a stake; thence N. 76-1/2 E. 52-1/2 feet to a stake; thence S. 12-1/4 E. 110-1/2 feet to a stake on Ann Street; thence with Ann St. S. 76-1/2 W. 56 feet to the beginning corner". Lot No. 2: Beginning at a stake at the corner of the lot above described and running thence N. 12-1/4 W. 110-1/2 feet to a stake; thence N. 76-1/2 E. 56-1/2 feet to a stake; thence S. 12-1/4 E. 110-1/2 feet to a stake on Ann Street; thence S. 76-1/2 W. 56 feet with Ann Street to the beginning corner".

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said premises belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and the reversions and the remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof; and also all the estate, right, title, interest, dower, possession, property, benefit, claim and demand whatsoever, both at law and in equity, of the said

Emma Ross and of all the parties to the said suit, and of all other persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, by, from or under them, or either of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises with its hereditaments, privileges and appurtenances unto the said Henry Campbell, his Heirs and Assigns forever.
