

W.A. Payne DEED TO J.H. Payne

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W.A. Payne of Greenville County

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Ten DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

J.H. Payne (the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J.H. Payne, all that certain parcel and lot of land situate and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina in Chick Springs Township, on the North side of Chick-Springs Road, having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stone on Chick Springs Road, on Tandy Dills line and runs, thence N. 65-1/2 E. 4.00 to a bend in Old road; thence N. 75-1/2 E. 4.00 to a stone; thence N. 9 E. 18.30 to a stone on Cox's corner; thence S. 41 W. 19.00 to a stake on Old line; thence S. 22 E. 7.00 to the beginning corner, and contains twelve and one-tenth (12-1/10) acres, more or less, bounded by lands of C.L. King, Tandy Dill and others and known as part of the H.L. King place, and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by L.J. & J.E. Johnson in deed bearing date March 4th, 1911 and recorded in Book 13, at page 61.
