Wallace of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other valuable considerations to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by E. B. Tesh (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

E. B. Tesh, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Ward Five in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid on West side of Peach Street, having a frontage of fifty-two (52) feet on said street and running back six hundred lines in depth 93.5 feet and being fifty-two (52) feet wide at rear and being the front portion of lot No. 21 in Block B of the subdivision known as Melville Land Company as shown on plat in office of R. M. C. in and for Greenville County, S. C. in plat Book "A" on page 89. On the lot herein conveyed are situated two new three room cottages. The lot herein conveyed is a part of the same lot of land conveyed by James Whitney and Florence Whitney to John H. Earle and W. A. Wallace by deed bearing date September 19, 1911 and recorded in office of R. M. C. in and for Greenville County, S. C. in vol. 10 at page 563. John H. Earle conveyed all his undivided one-half interest in and to all of the entire lot No. 21a portion of which is herein conveyed to W. A.
