 is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said
Louise D. Guion, all that piece, parcel and lot of land, situate in the State and County aforesaid, in the city of Greenville, in Ward One, at the northeast corner of *Tourne's* and *Elford* Streets and having the following mates, bounds, Courses and distances to wit: Beginning at corner of lot of *W. A. Bates*, on the East side of *Tourne's* St. and running thence *W. 13 W. 4 2 feet*, 4 inches, more or less, with *Tourne's* St. to the corner of *Tourne's* thence with *Elford* St. *S. 6 1/2 E. 5 1/2 feet*, 9 inches, thence *N. 18 3/4 E. 5 1/2 feet*, more or less, to line of said lot of *W. A. Bates*, 58 feet, 6 inches to the beginning point, and being the same lot of land Conveyed to me by *Mrs. L. T.
