KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Annie C. Webster of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of one dollar and natural love and affection

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by E. Agnew Webster of the same place (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

E. Agnew Webster, All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State aforesaid containing seven and five-tenths acres, more or less, according to plat by W.D. Neves, dated Mar., 28, 1913, and having the following lines: beginning at a poplar in gully; thence N. 40 W. four hundred and eighty (480) feet to iron pin; thence S. 53-30 W. seven hundred (700) feet to iron pin; thence S. 71-30 E. eight hundred and twenty (820) feet to iron pin; thence N. 16-15 E. three hundred and twenty six (326) feet to the beginning point.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said E. Agnew Webster, and his heirs and assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said E. Agnew Webster, and his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
