KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J.V. Smith

in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Ten dollars (\$10.00) and other valuable considerations DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

Mrs. Nora Smith (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Mrs. Nora Smith, All that certain lot of land designated as lot No. 3 and Lot No. 4 Block A, as described on the plat of the lands of the Melville Land Company, recorded in the office of the Register Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Plat Book page 59, above-described lots being a part of the sub-division of the lands bought by the Melville Land Company from L.C. Bolling, conveyed to W.B. Smith by J.S. Elmore by deed dated July 11th, 1911, as recorded in R.M.C. office in Volume 13, page 178, and later conveyed by W.B. Smith to me as recorded in R.M.C. Vol. 18, page 246, deed dated May 5th, 1913.

Also all that certain lot of land designated as Lot No. 1 in Block F, as described on plat of the lands of the Melville Land Company, recorded in the office of the Register Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, in plat book page 97, above-described lot being a part of the sub-division of the lands bought by the Melville Land Company from L.C. Bolling, conveyed to W.B. Smith by J.S. Elmore by deed dated July 11th, 1911, as recorded in R.M.C. office Vol. 13, page 178, and later conveyed to me by W.B. Smith by deed dated May 5th, 1913, as recorded in R.M.C. office Vol. 18, page 246.
