is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said
J.C. Milford, his heirs and assigns, all that lot of land situate on the South side of East
North Street, in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina, beginning at a stake on
said Street, one hundred and six feet West of the intersection of Pettigru and North Streets,

As part consideration of this conveyance, I assume payment of note, secured by mortgage of the
premises, said note for Twelve hundred dollars, dated May 17th, 1913 together with all
interest and terms as provided in said note, same being executed to Charles Jamison, Trustee.
