is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said  
Jos. A. McCullough, all that piece, parcel and lot of land in the State and County aforesaid,  
containing five and sixty-three one hundredths acres, more or less, and being lot no thirteen  
of the land conveyed to me by P.S. Butler on the 15th, day of 1908.

wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Jos. A. McCullough, his heirs and assigns forever.

forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Jos. A. McCullough, his

heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against  
every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
