(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Lizzie Cooksey, All that piece, parcel or lot of land, lying and being in the 4th. Ward of the City of Greenville on Fall & Murphy St. with three houses on same- Beginning at corner of Fall and Murphy Streets and running thence N. 20° E. 96 feet on and with Fall St. to a stake on J.Z. Phillips line, thence N. 70° W. 126 feet to Stewarts line, thence with Stewarts line, 96 feet to Murphy St., thence with said Murphy St. 126 feet to the beginning corner, being Lot No. 1, and a part of lot No. 2 of the Murphy lot conveyed to T. F. Hunt and H.W.-Hunt by J.C. Bailey, Judge of Probate, deed bearing date Jan. 2nd, 1899 and being the same lot conveyed to me by T. F. Hunt, Feb. 27th, 1905 and recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County Mch. 4th, 1905 in Vol. N.N.N. page 709.
