DEED TO John B Marshall

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That The City of Greenville, S.C.

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina, and having its principal place of business at Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Two Hundred and Ninety (\$2,200.00) DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinabove named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto John B Marshall

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated lying and being on the west side of Buncome Road just outside the incorporation limits of the City of Greenville, in said County and State, and having the following lines and bounds to wit: Beginning at a corner from my Buncome Street at the corner of lands formerly belonging to Mr. Pendleton, thence 57 feet to the hundred and thirty-one (131) feet to an iron pier on 30 foot alley, thence with said alleys 34° E. forty-six (46) feet to an iron pier, the corner of lot No. 15, thence 11.574 E. two hundred and nineteen (219) feet to an iron pier on Buncome Street, thence with Buncome Street N. 21 $\frac{3}{4}$ W. forty-seven (47) feet to beginning corner. This being the same lot of land, conveyed to the City of Greenville by L. B. Marshall by deed dated March 8th 1906, and recorded in Vol. 1555 page 122, and being known as lot No. 16 of the lands of the late Jas. W. Finlayson as a homestead tract, recorded in Vol. 7 N. N. at page 833. Also all that other piece, parcel or lot of land, situated, lying and being out west side of the Buncome Road just outside the incorporation limits of the City of Greenville, in said County and State and adjoining the above described lot, and having the following lines and boundaries: Beginning at a point at an iron pier on Buncome Street and running thence N. 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 122 feet to an iron pier, thence 3.56 $\frac{1}{2}$ N. 126 feet to an iron pier, thence S. 24 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 122 feet to an iron pier in line of Jas. W. Finlaysons line, thence N. 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 125 feet to an iron pier in line of Buncome Street, the beginning corner and being the same lot of land conveyed to the City of Greenville by C. F. Goodlett by deed dated November 21st 1905 and recorded in Vol. 8 R. P. page 217.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee... hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee... hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

In witness whereof the said granting corporation has caused its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and these presents to be subscribed by its duly authorized officers, C. S. Webb, as Mayor, and G. Frank Leogard as City Clerk, on this the Nineteenth day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and Seventeen, and in the one hundred and Forty-first year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
