KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Piedmont Savings & Trust Company

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and twenty DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto...

O.F. Hollingsworth, All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in subdivision known as West Park, just outside the City of Greenville, S.C. being known as lots Nos. 154 and 155 as shown by plat of West Park, recorded in plat book C., page 79 and 80, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County. This being a portion of a tract of land conveyed to us by Piedmont Savings & Investment Company by deed dated December 15, 1916, recorded in Vol. 25, page 353; and having been conveyed to Piedmont Savings and Investment Company by W.H. Irvine by deed dated April 24, 1913, recorded in Vol. 18, page 283, in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee...hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee... hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

In witness whereof the said granting corporation has caused its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and these presents to be subscribed by its duly authorized officers, F.F. Beattie, President and A.G. Taylor, Secretary on this the 4th, day of June, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighteen, and in the one hundred and 42nd. year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
