KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That *The Hayler Company,*

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of *South Carolina* and having its principal place of business at *Greenville* in the State of *South Carolina* for and in consideration of the sum of *Five Dollars and no other Consideration* DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto *W.R. Hale, Jr.*

All that certain lot of land situate in Greenville Township, in the County and State aforesaid known and designated as Lot #37 of Sans Souci Annex as shown on Plat recorded in Plat Book "C" page 29, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake on the corner of Interurban Avenue and Lee Street and running thence with said Avenue N. 42-40 E. 50 feet to stake corner of Lot #38; thence with line of lot 38 N. 42-20 W. 157.5 feet to stake on Alley; thence with said Alley S. 42-40 W. 50 feet to Lee Street; thence with said Street S 42-20 E. 157.5 feet to the beginning.
