KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Riverside Land Company

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

W. H. Parish and T. C. Gowen, that certain lot of land situated in the City of Greenville County and State aforesaid, in Block 6 on the south side of Main Street opposite Tusculum College, and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at the corner of W. H. Garrison line on said Main Street and running thence with the south side of Main Street as the line forty (40) feet to J. B. Earle's corner, (which corner is 38.5 ft - north of the corner of the lot sold by B. H. Owen and B. E. Owen to the New Drug Company) thence with J. B. Earle's line making an angle of 70 degrees and running back 150 ft. to a corner, thence making an angle of 90 degrees to the left and running parallel with South Main Street, 81.3 ft. to W. H. Garrison's line thence running to the left and making an angle (internal) of 70° 35'; and running thence with W. H. Garrison's line 156 feet, and 3 inches to the beginning corner. Being one of the lots of land conveyed to the Grantor by W. H. Babcock by deed dated Dec. 15th 1915 and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 36 page 85. This lot is subject to a mortgage in favor of the Farmers' Trust, Markley dated July 20th 1914, recorded in Vol. 39 page 152 of the R. M. C. Office on which there is due twenty five hundred (\$2500.00) dollars with interest from January 20th 1919 and the purchaser hereby assumes payment thereof.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee hereinabove named, and their heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee hereinabove named, and their heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
