KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That The Norwood National Bank of Greenville  
 a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of The United States of America and having its principal place of business at  
Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the  
 sum of Ten dollars and other valuable consideration DOLLARS,  
 to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee<sup>s</sup> hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby  
 acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto W. D. Parrish  
and J. C. Gower, all that certain lot of land situate in the city of  
Greenville, County and State aforesaid, is the block bounded on the  
 west by South Main St, on the north by E. M. Bee Ave. and having  
 the following meter and bounds: Beginning at a point in the center  
 of a 12 inch brick wall at the north east corner of lot here before con-  
 veyed by the Norwood National Bank to W. D. Parrish and J. C. Gower  
 by deed recorded in Vol 25 page 434 and in line of lot this day conveyed  
 by said Bank to Mills and Manning, and running thence with line of  
 Mills and Manning, along the center of said brick wall, S 70-01 E. 20ft-10-1/2  
 inches to the center of another 12 inch brick wall at a point 31ft-5  
 inches from the south side of E. M. Bee Ave. measuring along the  
 center of said last mentioned wall, thence with the center of said  
 last mentioned wall S. 20-49 W. 24ft-2 inches to the center of another  
 brick wall; thence with the center of the last mentioned brick  
 wall N. 70-01 W. 20ft-9 1/2 inches to the south east corner of lot here-  
 fore conveyed by the Grantor to the Grantee; thence with the  
 eastern line of said lot N. 20-39 E. parallel with and 100 ft. dis-  
 tant from the eastern line of South Main Street 24ft. 2 inches to the  
 beginning corner. Being a portion of the land conveyed to the  
 Grantor by See Harris by deed recorded in Vol. 20 page 290.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise  
 incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee<sup>s</sup> hereinabove named, and  
 their heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said  
 premises unto the grantee<sup>s</sup> hereinabove named, and their heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part  
 thereof.
