KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Paris Mountain Company

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

W. C. Cleveland, That piece, parcel or lot of land commencing at a stake on the South side of Thompson Road, at the corner of F. N. K. Bailey property, thence along line of said property S. 27-30 W. 137 1/2 ft. to a stake on line of the Austin property, thence along line of said property S. 40-45 E. 350 ft. to a stake, thence along line of Paris Mountain property N. 27-30 E. 400 ft. to a pine tree thence N. 5-15 W. 52 1/2 ft. to an iron pin on the South edge of Thompson Road, thence along said road S. 75-15 W. 100 ft. to a bend, thence continuing with Road N. 67-15 W. 124.5 ft. to the point of beginning, containing 3.32 acres more or less, surveyed June 1921 by R. E. Dalton, Engr.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee...hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee... hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
