KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, B.W. Woodward of the Town of Greers, in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars and other valuable considerations NOW/18/ to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

Mrs. Permelia A. Woodward (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Mrs. Permelia A. Woodward, All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land, situate, lying and being in the Town of Greers in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, and having the following metes, bounds and distances, to wit: Beginning at a stake on north side of Cemetery Street and runs thence N. 73 W. with L.B. Johnson's line two hundred feet to a stake on Mrs. E.A. Westmoreland's line; thence S. 27-1/2 W. thirty-eight feet to a stake Mrs. Permelia A. Woodward's corner; thence S. 73 E. two hundred feet to a stake on Cemetery Street; thence N. 27-1/2 E. thirty-eight feet to the beginning, and contains seventy-six hundred square feet.

TOGETHER WITH, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.
