KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, A.W. Cox of Greenville County

in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of Nine hundred and fifty DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

C.B. Culbertson of the same place (the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

C.B. Culbertson, All that lot or parcel of land lying, being and situate in County and State
aforesaid Containing nineteen acres, more or less the same being a part of the land conveyed to
me by Will Hammond and hath the following metes and bounds to wit. Bound by lands of A.G. Huff,
said A.B. Culbertson, myself and others, Commencing at a poplar near branch running thence S. 88
E. 3.22 to a stone on C.B. Culbertson line, thence S. 15 W. 10.43 to a stone 3X, thence S. 82-3/4
W. 10.50 to a point in road, thence N. 63-1/2 W. 5.25 to center of old Neely Ferry Road; thence
along said Road, thence N. 27-1/4 E. 16.50 to a bend in road; thence N. 2 E. 1.37 to a stone in
center of road, thence S. 79-3/4 E. 4.18 to center of branch, thence S. 11-1/2 E. 2.50 to bend in
branch; thence S. 26 E. 4.78 to beginning corner.
