KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J.M. Verdin, of Greenville County and
 in the State aforesaid
 in consideration of the sum of twenty-five hundred DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by
 A.B. Bramlett, of the State and County aforesaid (the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

A.B. Bramlett, All of that certain piece, parcel and lot of land, situate in Greenville County
 and State aforesaid, about one mile from Simpsonville on the Greenville and Laurens Road,
 adjoining lands of F.D. Hunter, J.A. Martin and others, being a part of the Amanda Stokes Land,
 with the exception of nine-tenths (9/10) of an acre bought from Mrs. Alice E. Hunter and
 having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at the intersection of the Greenville and
 Pelham Road and thence S. 42-1/2 E. 17.85 chains to a stone 3x; thence N. 29-1/2 E. 15.16 to center
 of road, thence with said road N. 42-1/2 W. 2.56 to a bend; thence N. 50-1/2 W. 3.30 to bend; thence
 N. 76 W. 7.17 to center of Pelham Road; thence S. 39-1/2 W. 3.80 to bend; thence S. 60-1/2 W. 6.38
 to the beginning, containing nineteen and one-eighth (19-1/8) acres, more or less, and being the

 forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said A.B. Bramlett, his

heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against
 every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
