KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W. M. Jordan of the city of Greenville in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Forty two hundred and fifty DOLLARS to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by L. A. Green (the receipt whereof is here-

by acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said L. A. Green, All that piece parcel and lot of land, situate lying and being in the State and county aforesaid and city of Greenville fronting on Norwood Avenue and being known as lot no. 14 on plat of W. A. Hudson, bearing date July 6th 1908 and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pin at corner of said lot next to land now or formerly of H. C. Hearley and running thence N. 34 W. Sixty two (62) feet along Norwood Avenue to point corner of said lot and lot no. 15 on said plat, thence S. 56 W. One hundred and sixty nine (169) feet to an iron pin thence S. 34 E. Sixty two (62) feet to an iron pin on Hearley's line, thence N. 56 E.
