Fowler of the state and (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said W. A. Fowler, his heirs and assigns forever, all of that certain piece, parcel and lot of land, situated in the state and County aforesaid, on the north side of the Breckinridge Bridge and Anderson Bridge roads, adjoining lands of L. A. Fowler, Mrs. Flore Green and others, having the following metes and bounds:— Beginning in center of road opposite a Black gun 3x thence down the road N. 77 1/4 E. 1120 chains to bend in road, thence N. 76 1/4 E. 12.50 to fork of road, thence with the Breckinridge Bridge road, N. 71 E. 4.00 to Peak W. W.
