KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, J. H. Mcbee & Taylor Mcbee of the County of Greenville, in consideration of the sum of Two (\$20.00) and other valuable considerations to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. R. Jenkinson,

(the receipt whereof is here-

by acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said J. R. Jenkinson, all of that certain piece, parcel, and lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, about two and one half miles from Greenville Court House, and near the Augusta road, and bounded by lands of W. P. Childers, wife of J. E. Earle, J. L. Rose, and H. Schwere, and having the following lines, bounds, corners and distances to wit: - Beginning at a stake at the corner of lands of H. Schwere, and J. R. Jenkins, and running, thence along Jenkins line S. 47 W. 30° to iron Pin. Thence along line of estate of J. E. Earle N. 75 1/4 W. 9.55 to a stake (cherry gone) thence S. 46 W. 1.91 to Red Oak stump then in N. 46 W. 5.60 to three white oaks, thence S. 47 1/4 W. 8.32 to red oak, then in N. 25 3/4 W. 30 links to iron pin, thence along line of W.
