Leopard and his heirs and assigns forever; All that piece, parcel or lot of land, in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, on Mulberry and Pinckney Streets; Beginning at the northwest corner of Mulberry and Pinckney Streets and running thence with Mulberry Street N. 35° 34' E., one hundred (100) feet to a stake; thence S. 54½ W., one hundred (100) feet to a stake on Pinckney Street; thence with Pinckney Street S. 36½ E., sixty-two (62) feet and four (4) inches to the beginning corner, containing seven thousand and fifty (7050) square feet, more or less, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Wm.
