Mills Mooney, his heirs and assigns forever all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the city of Greenville, county of Greenville and state aforesaid in ward three (3) on the east side of Bailey Street and running back in depth in parallel lines one hundred eighty-five (185) feet, containing seven thousand six hundred seventy-seven (7677) square feet, more or less, being the lot nearest to West Washington Street of lot conveyed to W. A. Wallace and W. W. Moore by James M. Russell by his deed dated January 30, 1912 and said deed being recorded in office of R. M. C. in and for Greenville County, South Carolina.

The lot of land herein conveyed being the same in which W. W. Moore conveyed his undivided one half interest to me (W. A. Wallace) by his deed dated March 6, 1912 and recorded in R. M. C. office in and for Greenville County, South Carolina in Vol. 20 at page 5.
