in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand (\$2000.00) and Two DOLLARS
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by W. Mills Mooney,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said W. Mills Mooney, his heirs and assigns forever all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate in the State aforesaid and being in the city of Greenville, county of Greenville and state aforesaid in Ward three (3) on the west side of Bailey Street and running back in depth in parallel lines one hundred eighty-five (185) feet containing seven thousand six hundred seventy-seven (7677) square feet from the corner of the lot nearest to West Washington Street of lot conveyed to W. A. Wallace and W. W. More by Mrs. M. Russell by her deed dated January 30, 1909 - said deed being recorded in office of Register of Deeds for Greenville County, South Carolina.

The lot of land herein conveyed being the same in which W. W. More conveyed half of his lot to me (W. A. Wallace) by his deed dated March 6, 1912 and recorded in R. M. C. office in and for Greenville county, South Carolina in Vol. 200 at page 5.

The lot of land herein conveyed contains thereon five (5) three room cottages. There is a well in the center of the lot as originally owned by Wallace and More and is in the division of the land between W. A. Wallace and W. W. More, this well fell on the line between the two lots the rights were divided alike - one to the other, by W. A. Wallace and W. W. More whereby the tenants on the two lots have the use of said well.

It is understood and agreed that the grantee herein assumes the payment of a note and mortgage for one thousand forty-one and $\frac{9}{10}$ Dollars (\$1041.90) executed by W. A. Wallace to Piedmont Saving + Investment Company, March 8, 1912.
