KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that A. J. Haynsworth of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars DOLLARS to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by C. W. Lake (the receipt whereof is here- by acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said C. W. Lake, all that certain parcel of land situated in the County and State aforesaid and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point on Section 19 of the lands of Greenville Carolina Power Company and running thence N 75 1/2 W 1/4 a corner of the same from the old bank of the Sa- luda River, being the old channel of the river of the aforesaid herein, and running thence N 25 1/4 W 11 2 1/2 chains thence N 5 1/2 E 19.57 chains thence N 8 1/2 E 2 1/2 chains to the old bridge road, thence with said road to the point where said road crosses Section 19 of the lands of the aforesaid Greenville Carolina Power Company, thence with said road in a southerly direction to the drainage of said river, the whole containing five (5) acres, more or less, as will more fully appear from the plat of the same made by P.
