(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Daniel W. Barton all my right, title and interest, in that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville according to plat thereof made by B. S. Nease and bearing date the 25th day of January 1911, and Survey attached thereto. Beginning at an iron pin on the New Bridge Road, and running thence N. 15° 21' 39" chains E. 20° 30' 00" thence N. 27° 40' E. 15° 52' E. to a stone on Mrs. Corrie Grier's line; thence S. 45° 1/2 W. 31.34 ch., to a stone, thence S. 15° 1/2 E. 13.34 ch., to an iron pin in New Bridge Road; thence along said road as the line in an easterly or north easterly direction 17.27 ch., to the beginning corner, containing fifty (50) acres, more or less, and being a portion of a certain tract of land conveyed to J.
