KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W. W. Hodson, of the County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by W. W. Miller, of the County of Greenville, State aforesaid, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said W. W. Miller, all of that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being on the east side of Pettigree Street, in the City and County of Greenville, and State aforesaid, and known as lots nos. Two (2) and Three (3) in Block 17 as shown on plat of "Boyce's Lawn Addition", same being made for J. T. Beattie, and recorded in Plat Book C at page 30 in the R. M. Office for Greenville County, and having the following metes and bounds to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in Towne Street at corner of lot of Kate C. Taylor, and running thence with Towne Street Sixty feet (60 feet) to corner, thence S. 72 E., 200 ft. distance line thence with said 60 feet line N. 20 E., 100 feet to Taylor's line, thence with said 200 ft. line N. 72 E., 200 feet to the beginning corner, same being the 2d of a stake, and to me by J. T. Beattie by deed bearing date the 3rd day of July, 1912, and recorded in Vol. 19 at page 303 in the Office of Register of Deeds for Greenville County.
