by acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said
C. S. Allen, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the
City of Greenville County and State aforesaid same being a portion of the Howley
Place, and having the following lines and bounds to-wit: - Beginning at a stake
on Laurens Avenue, joint corners of lots nos. 19 & 20 and running thence with Laurens
Avenue N. 21° 45' W. 168 feet to a stake, joint corners of lots nos. 20 and 21; thence
with said joint lines S. 16° 30' W. 180 feet to a stake on Glover Street; thence
with said Glover Street S. 21° 45' E. 68 feet to a stake, joint corners of lots nos.
19 & 21; thence with said joint lines N. 16° 30' E. 180 feet to a stake at the be-
