Surrine all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

in the City of Greenville, on the southeast corner of Frank Street and Hampton Avenue, beginning at a stake on the east side of Hampton Avenue and the south side of Frank Street at the corner of said Streets, and running thence S. 32-40 E. with Hampton Avenue forty-five feet to a stake, thence N. 57 E. one hundred feet to a stake; thence N. 32-40 W. forty-five feet in a line parallel with Hampton Avenue to a stake on Frank Street, and thence with Frank Street S. 57 W. one hundred feet to the beginning corner.
