- 3. An order in writing is required of a lot owner whenever a grave is to be opened, and a permit from the Board of Health must be shown the Superendent of grounds.
- 4. No double burials (that is, one body being placed above another) will be allowed, unless special permission be granted by the Superintendent,
- 5. No disinterment shall be allowed without permission of the Superintendent.
- 6. The Association, from time to time, may lay out or alter such avenues or walks, or make such rules and regulations for the government of the Cemetery grounds as they may deem requisite or proper to promote the general objects of the Cemetery.
- 7. The prices of lots include all charges for grading and care in accordance with the rules and regulations laid down by the Association and as referred to in Rule No. 10.
- 8. All sales of lots are made strictly for cash, unless in special cases an extension is given by the Association. This Association for itself, and successors and assigns, covenants that the lot or lots herein referred to and which is a part hereof, shall receive annual care hereafter of lawns, flowers, shrubs, trees and all headstones, curbing and other stone work kept plumb, straight or in proper condition, except such work as referred to in rule 9, the aim being to keep the lots in perpetuity for all time to come. The Association is not responsible for the wear or damage to monuments by the elements, and will not repair or replace them.
 - 11. No coping or other means of marking boundaries of lots or graves can be used except corner stones herein provided.
- 12. Monuments or portions of vaults, above ground, shall not be of material other than cut stone, granite, marble, or cement, but with the consent of the Superintendent other material may be used in erecting monuments, and vaults.
