To Have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the Grantee hereinabove named, and his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said Parker Land Company does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Grantee hereinabove named and his heirs and assigns from and against itself, and its successors and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

This deed is subject to the following restriction, which shall apply for a period of twenty-five years from date thereof;

That the property is not to be sold, or otherwise disposed of to persons of African descent.

In event of a violation by the purchaser of the restriction above made, the title of this tract shall revert to the Grantor, except as against lien creditors.
