Norwood, we the undersigned, as the other heirs at law and distributees of the said William Boyd Gleen do hereby assign, transfer, sell bargain and deliver unto the said Lula Glenn, her heirs and assigns, all our rights, title, interest and equity in both the real and personal property of the said William Boyd Glenn.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto the said Lula Glenn, her heirs and assigns forever, and especially do we direct the said Dr. W. M. Norwood upon compliance with said contract by the payment of the balance of the money, to make over and convey the legal title to the said four lots of land, unto the said Lula Glenn in fee simple.
