DECLARATION OF TRUST.

Harris do hereby agree and declare that I and my heirs and assigns do and shall forever ~~stand~~ seized of all my right, title and interest in and to the said alley known as Spring Street In Trust for those who purchased from me lots or may now own abutting thereon and their heirs and assigns forever.
