Smith (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Florrie L. Smith, her heirs and Assigns, all those certain pieces, parcels or tracts land herein below described as follows:

No. 1. All that lot of land situate, lying and being in Austin Township, State and County aforesaid, near the town of Mauldin, adjoining the home track of B.
